

Presentation of a simplified online diagnostic and planning service based on the concepts of Jean Delaire.

The interest of Jean Delaire's analysis, which makes it possible to determine graphically a theoretical ideal facial architecture for diagnostic and therapeutic purposes, is recognised by the majority. Nevertheless, the very large amount of information it provides is sometimes considered excessive by some surgeons, limiting its use to the detriment of patients. From an epistemological and geometrical reflection of Jean Delaire's analysis distinguishing the territories on which the surgeon cannot act and those on which he can interact, a focused Delairean analysis was developed. The aim of this lecture is to present this reflection and the online planning service offering this simplified analysis. The theoretical ideal surgical architecture is there reduced to its most relevant and faithful expression in order to facilitate diagnosis and surgical planning. The ability to generate surgical positioners gives the operator control over the surgical execution.
